Study Programmes for Exchange Students

Architecture

Exchange is available at both bachelor and master level. Applicants must be studying at the same level as the programme they are applying for.

Exchange students are expected to follow all courses within the chosen programme - it is not possible for students to choose individual courses.

Note that the teaching for Danish programmes is in Danish, but are nonetheless also open to English-speaking students, with guidance being given in English.

Design

Exchange applicants can apply to both bachelor- and master-level programmes.

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It is not possible for exchange students to take their final thesis project at the Academy.
